Resolution

Concerning Lowering the Meals Tax

April 27, 2020

WHEREAS... Waltham has been known as "Restaurant Row", as restaurants are the heart of downtown Waltham, and

WHEREAS... The current meals tax rate in Waltham is 7.0%, which comprises a 6.25% state tax and a 0.75% local option tax, and

WHEREAS... The local option meals tax became effective on Waltham on July 1st 2010, and

WHEREAS... Most restaurants in Waltham are locally-owned small businesses, and

WHEREAS... The recent COVID-19 crisis has drastically reduced restaurant income, and thus has negatively affected many of its lower wage workers;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED... that the City Council consider removing the 0.75% local option meals tax.
